Grand Junction (KGJT) is a Class D airport located in western Colorado. It can be found on the north side of the Denver Sectional, near the Utah border. We do not recommend that anyone attempt to fly directly across the Colorado Rockies from east to west unless they have had mountain flying training and are experienced with the Colorado mountains. We have two recommended VFR routes shown on our website.
